Monitor Permanent Way Infrastructure (Hot Weather)

Course Description

This module is designed to train persons who are responsible for undertaking monitoring duties of Track Assets as part of their duties on Network Rail Infrastructure during hot weather (as hot weather watchperson). It is designed to develop a person's knowledge, understanding and skills and is therefore particularly suited to persons required to prove their capability in these areas.

All persons nominated to monitor the permanent way infrastructure during periods of hot weather. 1. Must be a minimum age of 18. 2. Must hold a valid Sentinel Track Safety Card endorsed with PTS and IWA or COSS. 3. Must meet the medical requirements of Network Rail Standard NR/L2/OHS/00124 Medical Fitness Level 1. 4. Must have a good level of literacy to meet Entry Qualifications. 5. Must meet the requirements of Network Rail Standard NR/L1/OHS/051 (Drugs & Alcohol).
