Monitor Permanent Way Infrastructure (Hot Weather)

It is designed to develop a person's knowledge, understanding and skills and is therefore particularly suited to persons required to prove their capability in these areas.

Must hold a valid Sentinel Track Safety Card endorsed with PTS and IWA or COSS. 3. Must meet the medical requirements of Network Rail Standard NR/L2/OHS/00124 Medical Fitness Level 1. 4. Must have a good level of literacy to meet Entry Qualifications. 5. Must meet the requirements of Network Rail Standard NR/L1/OHS/051 (Drugs & Alcohol).
