Participants will also understand the decision-making process and the possible outcomes. Effective communication skills are crucial in conducting tactical evaluation, and this course will demonstrate how to use them effectively. Finally, participants will learn how to tactically evaluate data sets, providing them with the skills and knowledge needed to make informed decisions in high-pressure situations. Recommended pre-learning for this course: Drainage & Lineside - Drainage Inspection and Maintenance Level 1. It is also recommended that delegates familiarise themselves with the following tools before attending this training course: StrEAMS, ARET, Geo-RiNM, Ellipse, Fault Management System. These systems will be referenced extensively throughout the course and will form part of the final practical assessment.
