Course Description

- Advanced Tools: Gain insights into specific tools like the Convective Alerting Tool and Precipitation Analysis Tool.

This course is specifically designed for operational staff within Network Rail who are responsible for using the weather forecast to help make operational decisions on the impact of weather on the railway. It is particularly relevant for Route Controllers, Senior Network Duty Managers (S/NDMs), Seasonal Delivery Specialists/Managers (SDS/Ms), Incident Controllers, Route Asset Managers (RAMs), Delivery Unit managers and Train/Freight Operating Company operational personnel. Whether you are new to your role or have years of experience, this course will provide you with the tools and knowledge to effectively navigate the Network Rail Weather Service.
