Drainage & Lineside - Boundary Measures Tactical Evaluation Level 2

Course Description

This face-to-face training course is designed for individuals looking to enhance their knowledge of tactical evaluation within the context of boundary measures. Throughout the course, participants will discuss the purpose of tactical evaluation, explore common triggers for tactical evaluation, and learn how to manage risk during tactical evaluations. Participants will gain an understanding of the decision authorisation process and possible outcomes, as well as the importance of effective communication skills whilst conducting tactical evaluations. Overall, participants will gain a deeper understanding the skills and knowledge needed to make informed decisions in high-pressure situations. Recommended pre-learning for this course: Boundary Measures Inspection & Maintenance Level 1. It is also recommended that delegates familiarise themselves with the following tools before attending this training course: StrEAMS, ARET, Geo-RiNM, Ellipse, Fault Management System. These systems will be referenced extensively throughout the course and will form part of the final practical assessment.
